



SWITCHING TO A METERED SERVICE

More and more of Guernsey Water's customers are now having water meters fitted – in fact there are now more metered customers than there are unmetered customers in the island!

The Figures

No. of Occupiers	Average Quarterly Usage	2024 Quarterly Bill (including standing charge)
1	15 cubic metres	£97.19
2	30 cubic metres	£147.08
3	45 cubic metres	£196.97
4	60 cubic metres	£246.86
5	75 cubic metres	£296.75

If you have a water meter fitted to your property, you are charged according to the quantity of water that you actually use, rather than the TRP of your property. Please note, the above charges are based on average water use.

How can I use less water?

In The Kitchen

- 💧 Mend that leaky tap! And never leave a tap running
- 💧 Only use your washing machine & dishwasher on a full load
- 💧 Store drinking water in a jug in the fridge rather than waiting for the tap to run cold.

In The Bathroom

- 💧 Taking a quick shower uses a lot less water than a bath.
- 💧 Turn the tap off whilst you brush your teeth!
- 💧 Put the plug in the basin and only run as much water as you need

In The Garden

- 💧 Use a water butt to collect rainwater, use this water for watering plants
- 💧 Use a watering can instead of a hosepipe or sprinkler
- 💧 Water plants when its cool (early morning or during the evening) to reduce evaporation
